Details for Implementation

of the

Letter of Understanding

on the

Exchange of Scientists

between

The Danish Rectors' Conference and the Chinese Academy of Sciences

In accordance with the provisions of article 7 of the Letter of Understanding on the exchange of scientists between DRC and CAS, the details for implementation have been agreed upon as follows:

I. Procedure

- 1. The sending side will nominate candidates for exchange at least 4 months in advance of their proposed date of visit.
- 2. In making the nomination, the sending side will provide the receiving side with necessary data on each candidate using the forms prescribed by the receiving side.
- 3. The receiving side will send its acceptance notice to the sending side at least 2 months in advance of the proposed date of visit.

II. Financial support

- 1. The sending side will cover international transportation between the two countries according to its own rules.
- 2. The receiving side will provide the visitors with an allowance and pay domestic travel expenses as follows:

Ph.D.s

DRC will provide a monthly scholarship of 6,800 DKK to the Chinese researchers.

CAS will provide the following financial support to the Danish researchers:

- a monthly allowance of 1800 Chinese Yuan
- guesthouse room expenses.

Post doc's

DRC will provide financial support to the Chinese researchers as follows:

- a monthly salary of approx. 20,981 DKK plus allowances according to the Danish salary scheme
- a basic project support of 30,000 DKK to be paid to the Danish host institution.

CAS will provide the following financial support for the Danish researchers:

- a monthly allowance of 2100 Chinese Yuan
- guesthouse room expenses.

Short-term visits

DRC will provide for Chinese researchers:

- a daily allowance of 1,011 DKK for the first 28 days and a daily allowance of 759 DKK for the rest of the visit to cover living expenses and accommodation
- domestic travel expenses of up to 3,000 DKK.

CAS will provide for Danish researchers:

- a daily allowance of 700 Chinese Yuan for the first 20 days and a daily allowance of 500 Chinese Yuan for the rest of the visit (within 30 days) to cover living expenses, accommodation and domestic travel expenses.

Both sides will decide by mutual discussion the financial arrangements for visits involving more expenses, such as field expeditions and sample collecting, to cover accompanying scientists, local guides, special transportation and logistical service. In principle, the sending side is required to contribute half of the expenses for this kind of visits in the host country.

III. Other matters

- 1. The proposed visitor is required to possess sufficient command of English.
- 2. The proposed visitor is required to have been in contact with and to have made arrangements for his/her visit with his/her prospective host scientist(s) or institution(s) in the receiving country.
- 3. The visitor is required to conduct his/her research in the host institution on the following conditions:
 - 1) The Danish host institution must have postgraduate programmes for Danish Ph.D. students, and Danish host researchers must be employed at or affiliated with institutions of the following type:
 - a) DRC member institutions (cf. annex 1).
 - b) Public research institutions cooperating with Danish universities or research institutions recognized by DRC (cf. annex 1).
 - 2) Chinese host institutions must be affiliated with CAS (cf. annex 2).

- 4. Visitors must follow the receiving side's program provisions and regulations.
- 5. The "year" or the "fiscal year" referred to in the Letter of Understanding and Details for Implementation runs from January 1 to December 31. Remaining exchange quotas from one year cannot be carried over to the next year.
