
A WORLD AND A UNIVERSITY CHANGING

The universities are changing and their place in society is very different now compared to just a few decades ago. Earlier, only a select few of each generation were able to obtain a higher education. Today it is almost one in four. The focus of the universities used to be on educating graduates for the public sector. Today the majority of graduates find employment in the private sector. Before, the research activities were mainly anchored in the institutions. Today there is a comprehensive and close cooperation with authorities and the business community.

The world is experiencing a new era of global knowledge-based economy in which research, innovation and highly qualified employees are in demand and are essential to Denmarks' global competitiveness.

Denmark and the rest of the world is also facing a series of societal challenges like climate, energy, health and inequality. Research and new knowledge is essential in order to overcome those challenges. At the same time it is clear that these challenges can't be resolved by one country alone. In this regard, the close international cooperation with research environments all over the world is essential to Denmark's ability to contribute to finding the answers that will help solve the big societal challenges.

The technological developments are also changing the world. Digital skills are highly sought after, and



artificial intelligence is changing the future labour market. Some jobs will disappear, new will arise.

In this regard, the academic process, critical thinking and ability to solve problems will become increasingly important because these skills are not easily replaced by technology.

New technology has given us almost endless information, but it also provides an outlet for dubious or twisted flows of information. This highlights the role of the universities' in development and dissemination of impartial and reliable knowledge. The world is changing and now more than ever, research, educational programs and dissemination of knowledge from the universities is needed.

PROGRAMS OF TOMORROW

The universities produce skilled and innovative graduates that contribute to the societal development and create value in the labour market.

The universities will:

- Educate according to the demands of society

 The universities will coordinate the supply of programs, so they meet the demands of the future labour market.
- Strengthen the access to lifelong learning
 The universities will collaborate on developing
 possibilities for lifelong learning and to increase the
 flexibility and coherence in the educational system.
- Promote excellent teaching
 The universities will strengthen the research based teaching through a shared and strong focus on and recognition of excellent teaching.
- **Give students skills of tomorrow**The universities will contribute to the prevalence of formation, critical thinking and cooperation as well as strengthen digital and technological skills.





The universities contribute with groundbreaking knowledge, insight and cognition which in interaction with the surrounding community contribute to new solutions to local and global challenges including a sustainable development.

The universities will:

- Strengthen the basis for national research efforts
 The universities will identify central research needs,
 strengthen the basis for coordinated research efforts
 and together promote solutions to local and global challenges.
- Promote the cooperation with businesses across the country

The universities will strengthen the cooperation with both large and small businesses in order to promote research and innovation across the country.

Strengthen public innovation and the political decision-making-process

The universities will increase the cooperation with public organisations and authorities so the most recent research can benefit the public sector and the political decision-making-processes

Share new research to benefit all programs

The universities will cooperate with other educational institutions in order to increase the interaction between research and everyday life and contribute to the prevalence of new knowledge to all programs.

• Let every talent flourish


Through a joint effort, the universities will promote diversity among researchers and students regardless of their social background to let every talent flourish.
